NOTES:

Article VII of the Submarine Telegraph Convention, 1844 (scheduled to the Submarine Telegraph Act, 1885), provides as follows:

"Owners of ships or vessels who can prove that they have sacrificed an anchor, a net, or other fishing gear in order to avoid injuring a submarine cable, shall receive compensation from the owner of the cable."

"In order to establish a claim for such compensation, a statement, supported by the evidence of the crew, should, whenever possible, be drawn up immediately after the occurrence; and the master must, within twenty four hours after his return to, or next putting into port, make a declaration to the proper authorities."

- The form is to be checked by a Fisheries Officer of the proper authority (MMO in England, Marine Scotland in Scotland, DARD in Northern Ireland or WAGAFD in Wales) at the first port of arrival following the alleged incident.
- The form is to be posted to the company believed to be the owner or operator of the cable involved (see KIS-ORCA Cable Awareness Charts for assistance and information).
- The incident is to be reported to the proper authority within 24 hours of arrival at that port, as above.
- A description and estimate of the present value of the gear, supported by receipts and/or estimates for replacement gear, should be detailed on separate sheets. A photocopy of the relevant page(s) of the vessels deck log book covering the incident should be included with the claim where appropriate. (Mariner's Handbook NP100, covering claims for loss of gear from fouling on submarine cables and pipelines, states that an entry of any incident must be made in the deck log book). It is essential that the vessel owner making the claim submits the vessel VMS data in the form of a track plot for the period 12hrs before the incident and 12hrs after the incident. If the VMS data is not submitted this could invalidate any claim. In addition, evidence of the use of Cable Awareness Charts will be required to support any claim.
- The data submitted on this form will be handled in accordance with the data retention and management policies of the receiving company and their GDPR policies. The European Subsea Cables Association does not accept any liability for the handling of the provided data or for any adverse consequences arising from its provision.

A correctly completed form supported by the necessary documentation will greatly assist the cable owner in determining whether compensation is applicable and, if it is, will result in faster settlement.

Along with this documentation a copy of your Buyers and sellers data from 3 weeks prior to the cable operations, during the operations and then 3 weeks after the operations is required. From this data a daily average will be calculated, taking into consideration the continuation of fishing, and from this a disturbance value will be calculated. NOTE 5

Where applicable vessels must submit logbook data with fishing positions for the 3 weeks prior to cable operations, during operations and then 3 weeks after the operations. NOTE 6

Notes:

- 1. The claimant should provide his full name and address here.
- 2. The form is to be posted to the company believed to be the owner or operator of the cable involved (see KIS-ORCA Cable Awareness Charts for assistance and information).
- 3. The cable owner or his agent will provide this information.
- 4. Any supporting information which will strengthen the claim should be detailed on separate sheets.
- 5. Buyers and Sellers data must be in the form of buyer's information or sales notes.
- 6. This is only applicable to vessels over 10 metres.
- 7. Please note that evidence of the use of Cable Awareness Charts will be required, as will (where applicable) vessel VMS data for the vessel track 12 hours prior to and through to 12 hours after the incident.
- 8. The data submitted on this form will be handled in accordance with the data retention and management policies of the receiving company and their GDPR policies. The European Subsea Cables Association does not accept any liability for the handling of the provided data or for any adverse consequences arising from its provision.
